

# ENERGY POLICY

British Sugar's Energy Policy is to minimise the environmental impact and financial costs of our energy generation, use, import and export across operations at our beet processing sites by:

- Reducing our energy usage and greenhouse gas emissions in absolute terms, per tonne of raw material processed, and per tonne of product
- Committing to stop burning coal for power generation and animal feed drying by April 2023
- Enhancing our energy performance through the continual improvement of the energy management system and a process of measuring and regularly reviewing energy performance against 'true potential', whilst evaluating our significant energy impacts
- Taking energy performance into account in the design, procurement, and implementation of all capital investments, plant modifications, and operational changes
- Fulfilling our compliance obligations for all appropriate legislation and other requirements relating to the activities of the Company.

This policy statement is communicated to all of British Sugar's employees and contractors whose activities impact on energy.
